In the app you have access to digital member cards, maps of the Garden, renewal reminders, and a list of the gardens, arboretums, and conservatories you can visit from the AHS Reciprocal Admission Program.



1. To find the app, scan the QR Code above or search for eMembership Card from the App Store or Google Play. Download the app to your phone by clicking "Install".



- 2. The app will ask for location data, which is not required to use the app. We recommend that you agree to receiving notifications, so that you can get reminders about *Night Lights* tickets and membership renewal dates. You may opt out at any time.
- 3. Search New England Botanic Garden and select the tile.



4. To activate your digital cards, select the button "Find My Membership Cards".



5. To find your cards, type in your Patron ID number (Member ID number) and the last name of the primary cardholder. The Patron ID number is a three-to-five-digit number listed on your current member cards or on the receipt from your membership purchase. If you cannot locate your number, please call 508-869-6111 for assistance.
