

Parts of a Flower

Stamen

male part of a flower

Pistil

female part of a flower

Filament

holds up the anther

Anther

produces pollen grains

Stigma

catches pollen

Style

connects the stigma to the ovary

Ovary

stores the ovule or ovules

Petal

attracts insects and mammals to the flower for pollination

Sepal

protection for the flower and support for the petals when in bloom

Ovule

contains the embryo sac
