## Night Lights Group Visits

New England Botanic Garden at Tower Hill is one of the region's premier locations for your holiday outing. During the festive season, our formal gardens and conservatories are canvases for stunning, interactive light spectacles created by our very own horticultural team that will leave your group inspired. Whether an employee outing or gathering of family and friends, group visits to Night Lights provide a unique experience that you and your party will talk about for years to come.

# The Details

Groups of 20 or more **who arrive by bus** will receive 20% off Night Lights admission upon previous arrangement. Pricing depends on the date of your visit, as there are peak and off-peak pricing dates.

**Hours of Event:** 4pm–10pm (final entry is 8:30pm)

We recommend allowing for approximately 1-3 hours to enjoy the exhibition.

**Non-Peak Nights:** Sunday through Thursday

**Peak Nights:** Friday and Saturday, and 12/26–12/31

**Closed:** 12/24 and 12/25

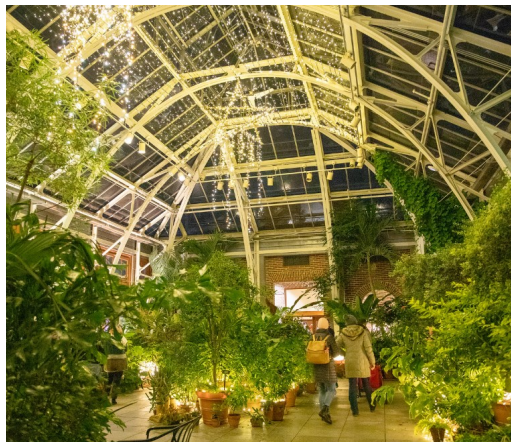

# The Details

## Dining

Groups are welcome to visit the Farmer and the Fork café for hot cocoa, apple cider, cider donuts, winter cocktails and savory, seasonal grilled cheeses. The café is open nightly until 9:30pm. Please note that seating is limited during Night Lights and we do not recommend bringing a picnic dinner. *Outside alcohol is not permitted on property.*

## Payment

To confirm group visit, a signed agreement and payment must be made one week in advance of your visit date. Final guest count is due at time of payment.

## Accessibility

New England Botanic Garden's formal gardens and all of its indoor facilities (conservatories, classrooms, café, and restrooms) are wheelchair and stroller accessible. Some of the garden paths and walkways are cement, brick, and bluestone. There are benches along the paths to stop and sit.

## Bus Drop Off & Parking

Buses may drop off guests near the entrance walkway to the Visitors Center. The drop-off area is located at the top, right side of the entry drive at the "No Parking Drop Off Only" sign. Buses should then park in the parking lots in the designated bus parking area (follow parking lot signs) and can schedule a pickup time with the group leader back at the entry path.

## Cancellation/ Rescheduling

Night Lights takes place in all weather conditions, but if weather presents a risk to safety, New England Botanic Garden may decide to cancel an evening of Night Lights. If this occurs, you will be notified about the cancellation by email by 2pm on the day of your visit. If there are no other dates available to reschedule your group visit, groups will receive a full refund.

Groups may choose to reschedule on their own once based on availability for an additional fee of \$50.
