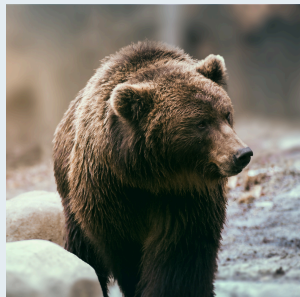


TRACK MATCHUP
