New England Botanic Garden at Tower Hill is one of the region's premier locations for your private event, offering a serene backdrop of gardens, woodlands, meadows, and mountain views that will leave your guests inspired. No matter the occasion, whether it is a bridal or a baby shower, or birthday, retirement, or cocktail party, New England Botanic Garden provides a picturesque environment that your guests will talk about for years to come.

In addition to beautiful event space, daytime socials include Garden admission for your guests. Each season offers a different garden experience. Spring brings beautiful bulbs including daffodils, tulips, and more. Summer gardens feature dramatic, colorful displays of annuals and perennials. In autumn, views of fall foliage are unmatched in the region, and winter at the Garden offers an escape from the cold as guests explore our subtropical conservatories.

Several event spaces are available depending on the needs of your event. All pricing includes use of a variety of table sizes, conference-style chairs, and Garden admission for all your guests.

*Conservatories are available from approximately Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend. Please note that the conservatories are not air conditioned and daytime rentals in July and August are not recommended.

Payment

A non-refundable 50% deposit of your rental fee is required at the time of contract-signing in order to guarantee arrangements with New England Botanic Garden. The remaining 50%, plus taxes and a bar security deposit of \$250 (if hosting 100+ people with a bar), is due 30 days prior to your event date.

Audio-Visual Equipment

Wireless internet access is available. A limited supply of audio/visual equipment is available for rent when ordered in advance. If available, this includes: LCD projector (\$200), laptop (\$100), Bose speaker with microphone (\$200), additional microphone (\$25).

Décor

You are welcome to bring in decorations to customize your space. We ask that you not bring balloons, confetti, or glitter, and that any flames are enclosed in glass (such as votive holders or hurricane glass). Décor must be free-standing and not affix to walls, ceilings, or plants. The Garden plants and flowers are not able to be moved into or out of event spaces, so feel free to bring in your own arrangements. Ask your Event Specialist for a complete list of décor specifics.

Chairs

While our house conference-style chairs are included in your rental price, our white garden chairs and fruitwood Chiavari chairs with white cushions are available for an upgraded price. Chair prices are as follows: \$100 for up to 25 chairs, \$200 for 26-50, \$300 for 51-80, \$400 for 81-120.

New England Botanic Garden at Tower Hill maintains a list of approved caterers who are familiar with our policies. The caterer provides all linens, silverware, dishes, and glassware for the tables. Alternate caterers and self-catering are not permitted.

Limonaia

The Limonaia is a conservatory (or greenhouse) designed to house collections of non-hardy plants such as citrus, palms, agave, camellias, orchids, and more during the colder months.
