In autumn, views of fall foliage are unmatched in the region. Winter at the Garden offers an escape from the cold as guests explore our subtropical conservatories.

Accessibility

New England Botanic Garden at Tower Hill is committed to accessibility for all guests. All of our indoor facilities (and many of our outdoor gardens) are wheelchair accessible. We can provide a Hearing Loop System upon request for guests who experience hearing loss. Ask your Event Specialist for more information.

Payment

A non-refundable 50% deposit of your rental fee is required at the time of contract-signing. If hosting 100+ guests with bar service, a refundable \$250 security deposit is required. For daytime events hosting 150+ guests with bar service, a police detail is required at an additional cost.

Membership

A membership to New England Botanic Garden at the "Friend" level is included in the rental rate.

Event Insurance

Event insurance is included in the rental cost and is provided through a third-party in conjunction with the venue. Coverage includes general liability (\$1,000,000 minimum) and property damage.

^{**}Conservatories are available from approximately Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend. Conservatories are not air conditioned. Daytime rentals in July and August are not recommended.

Event Locations



The Limonaia is a conservatory (or greenhouse) designed to house collections of non-hardy plants such as citrus, palms, agave, camellias, orchids, and more during the colder months. The Limonaia is surrounded by beautiful views of our Winter Garden on one side and The Court on the other. Its curved beams and contemporary architecture fit perfectly with popular décortrends.



The Southeast Link is an intimate space with floor to ceiling windows, slate floors, and views of our formal gardens and forest. All food and beverage must come through Peppers Artful Events for events in this space.



The Orangerie, like the Limonaia, is a conservatory for greenhouse) designed to house collections of non-hardy plants such as citrus, palms, agave, camellias, orchids, and more during the colder months. It is a modern interpretation of an eighteenth-century-style greenhouse. With its glass ceiling and stunning architecture, this space will give you that "wow" factor you're looking for.



The Reservoir Room is a bright, open space, with copper ceiling details and a wall of windows. The room includes a private terrace with beautiful views of Mount Wachusett and the Wachusett Reservoir.

Chairs: While our house conference-style chairs are included in your rental price, our white garden chairs and fruitwood Chiavari chairs are available for an upgraded price. Chair prices are as follows:

The Garden plants and flowers are not able to be moved into or out of event spaces, so feel free to bring in your own arrangements. All flames must be encased in glass (such as votive holders or hurricane glass). Prohibited items include balloons, confetti, and glitter. Ask your Event Specialist for a complete list of décor specifics.
